## How an entrant can change from one race to the other

Frequently there are situations in which an entrant wants to switch from one race to the other. There are two easy ways this can be done.

**Before the race:** (NOTE – ALL CHANGES “BEFORE THE RACE” MUST BE COMPLETED BY **MARCH 17<sup>TH</sup>**. OTHERWISE THEY WILL BE HANDLED ON RACE DAY)

- Send an email to [samcosta@indyrunners.org](mailto:samcosta@indyrunners.org) and explain your situation.
- If you are switching from the Half to the Quarter, the race database can be updated with no further fees or input from you.
- If you are switching from the Quarter to the Half, the race database will be updated after receiving a fee equal to the difference in the cost of the two races. That fee is \$10. You must send a check to:

On the front corner of the envelope mark “Race change” and include a note inside.

Either way when you arrive on race day the change will in place as if it were your original intent.

### **At the race:**

- Pick up your race gear (chip/bib) and shirt, take it to the “Information Center”. Tell them you wish to change races.
- They will take your race gear and shirt and provide you with new gear and a new shirt
  - If you are switching from the Half to the Quarter, no additional fee is needed.
  - If you are switching from the Quarter to the Half, a fee equal to the difference in the cost of the two races will be required. That fee is \$10.

Whatever you do, be a friend to the “Costa” and to the other participants and never run in the wrong race, or with someone else’s number, or give your number to someone else to run as you. This plays havoc with our overall results, our age group results, and often our gender specific results. We are experts at changes and transfers and can make them very effectively and efficiently, either before the race, or on race day. We want the “Costa” to be as accurate as possible, and we believe you do too. If we work together it will be!
